## EASTER VIGIL AND EASTER SUNDAY COMMUNION ANTIPHON

Christ our Passover has been sacrificed, alleluia; therefore let us keep the feast with the unleavened bread of purity and truth, alleluia, alleluia. (Roman Missal)

#### **Christ Our Passover**

1. Alleluia, Christ our Passover
Has for us been sacrificed,
Alleluia, alleluia;
Therefore let us keep the feast,
With the bread of truth unleavened,
Holy bread of purity;
Alleluia, alleluia,
Paschal Lamb we feast on Thee.

#### **Believe and Understand**

- 1. Thomas, feel the place and see, Alleluia! Where the nails have pierced my hands, Alleluia! Do not unbelieving be, Alleluia! But believe and understand, Alleluia!
- 2. Praise the Lord this glorious day, Alleluia! His great mercy always sure, Alleluia! Let the House of Jacob say: Alleluia! "Ever shall his love endure," Alleluia!
- 3. Stone the builders had denied, Alleluia! Has become the cornerstone, Alleluia! What a marvel in our eyes, Alleluia! By the Lord has this been done, Alleluia!
- 4. Father, Son, and Paraclete, Alleluia! Blessed Triune God adore; Alleluia! Though we see not, we believe, Alleluia! Sing your praises evermore, Alleluia!

1. The disciples recognized, In the breaking of the bread, Their Redeemer, Jesus Christ, Who is risen from the dead.

#### Refrain:

Jesus was revealed to them In the breaking of the bread.

- 2. The Lord Jesus is alive, And to Peter did appear; Alleluia he is ris'n, In this bread our Lord is here.
- 3. The Christ had to suffer death, But upon the third day rose, So that nations of the earth, Hear forgiveness and good news.
- 4. Sing to God, alleluia, Sing to God and bless his name; Day to day, alleluia, His salvation we proclaim.
- 5. Jesus said unto his friends, Come and eat with me this bread; And he gave some unto to them, After rising from the dead.

# FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER COMMUNION ANTIPHON

The Good Shepherd has risen, who laid down his life for his sheep and willingly died for his flock, alleluia. (Roman Missal)

#### The Good Shepherd Is Arisen

- 1. The Good Shepherd is arisen, Alleluia! For his sheep his life was given, Alleluia! Laid his life down willingly, Alleluia! That his flock may be redeemed. Alleluia!
- 2. Jesus said, "My sheep I know, Alleluia! They will follow where I go; Alleluia! I know mine and mine know me; Alleluia! Into life my flock I lead." Alleluia!
- 3. For my shepherd is the Lord, Alleluia! Through his care and holy word, Alleluia! All my wants shall be supplied; Alleluia! To green pastures does he guide. Alleluia!
- 4. *Pastor bonus surrexit,* Alleluia! Let our praise of him repeat; Alleluia! With the Father, Spirit, One, Alleluia! Praise the Shepherd, Risen Son. Alleluia! *(To V 1)*

I am the true vine and you are the branches, says the Lord. Whoever remains in me, and I in him, bears fruit in plenty, alleluia. (Roman Missal)

#### I Am the Vine

1. Lord Jesus said "I am the vine, My branches you will be. If you remain in me, you shall Bear fruit abundantly."

2. "Do you not know that in my face The Father you can see? For I am in the Father and The Father is in me."

3. All praise to God the Father be, And to his Risen Son, Who with the Holy Spirit reign, The Blessed Three in One. (*To V. 1*)

## If You Love Me, Follow My Word.

1. "If you love me, follow my word; I'll ask my Father," says the Lord, "And he will send a Paraclete To 'bide with you eternally,"

To 'bide with you eternally."

- 2. "When I return, your heart will praise, You are not orphans all your days; I have called you from 'midst the world, To go and bear fruit that will endure, To go and bear fruit that will endure."

## ASCENSION OF THE LORD COMMUNION ANTIPHON

*Vigil*: Christ, offering a single sacrifice for sins, is seated for ever at God's right hand, alleluia.

Day: Behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age, alleluia. (Roman Missal)

#### Behold, I Am With You Always

1. Christ made one single sacrifice To wash away our sins; And took his seat at God's right hand; His reign will never end. "Behold, I am with you always Until the ages' end."

2. "All pow'r and might is giv'n to me In heaven and on earth, Go teach all nations, baptize them In waters of new birth. In Father, Son and Holy Ghost, Go baptize all the earth."

3. These signs will manifest to those With faith in every land:
They cast out demons, heal the sick By laying on their hands;

Father, I pray that they may be one as we also are one, alleluia. (Roman Missal)

## Father, I Pray That They Be All One

1. "Father, when I have dwelt amongst them, I kept those who have kept your word, But now I come to you, my Father, Do not take them out of the world, But be their safeguard from all evil," Alleluia, Alleluia, "Father, I pray that they be all one, As you and I are also one."

2. God ever in his holy dwelling, gathers us all to dwell as one; He to his people strength upwelling, gives plentif'lly to ev'ryone. Let God arise, his foes be scattered; Let those who hate him flee in fright. Praise Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Blest Trinity, the Lord of Might. (*To V. 1*)

The Roman Gradual antiphon is drawn from the scripture passage that immediately precedes the missal antiphon. Therefore, this verse includes the full text of both.

# PENTECOST/CONFIRMATION COMMUNION ANTIPHON

*Vigil:* On the last day of the festival, Jesus stood and cried out: If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink, alleluia (Roman Missal)

Day: They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke of the marvels of God, alleluia. (Roman Missal)

Confirmation Mass (outside Lent): Rejoice in the Lord, all you who have been enlightened, who have tasted the gift from heaven and have been made sharers in the Holy Spirit (E.T. alleluia). Hebrews 6:4

## Fount of Mercy, Holy Spirit

1. "Come to me all who are thirsty,
Drink the water that I give,
Those with faith, as scripture promised,
Will be filled with grace and live;
Like a river, living water,
Flowing from those who believe,
Fount of mercy, Holy Spirit,
Which my faithful will receive."

2. Suddenly a sound from heaven, Like the rush of mighty wind Filled the place where they were sitting, And the Spirit entered in; Forth they went to speak the glory And the marvels of our God; Fount of Mercy, Holy Spirit, Fill all hearts the earth abroad!

3. Come rejoice in God and glory, You who have enlightened been; Sharers in the Holy Spirit, You who taste the gift of heav'n. Alleluia, you have feasted On the goodness of the word; Fount of mercy, Holy Spirit, Gift of God, our Sovereign Lord. The Roman Gradual antiphons match the Missal, but are longer. The longer version is adapted here.

You can rearrange the verses according to which one is the primary antiphon; Vigil, Day, or Confirmation.

Repeat the antiphon of the day as Vs 4.

#### TRINITY SUNDAY COMMUNION ANTIPHON

Since you are children of God, God has sent into your hearts the Spirit of his Son, the Spirit who cries out: Abba, Father. (Roman Missal)

#### Abba, Father, God Thou Art

1. Since you are God's precious children, He has sent into your hearts Spirit of his Son Begotten, Who from you shall ne'er depart, For this Spirit cries out in you: "Abba, Father, God thou art."

2. Let us bless the God of Heaven; Utter praise and thankfulness, For his mercy he has given, Dealt us love in faithfulness. Alleluia, alleluia, Triune God we ever bless.

3. "Unto me all pow'r is given, In the heavens and on earth, Go and baptize all the nations In the waters of rebirth; In the Father, Son, and Spirit, Go and baptize all the earth." (To V. 1) Verse 1 is the Roman Missal antiphon

#### Verse 2 is Roman Gradual, Years A and C

Let us bless the God of Heaven and utter his praises before all who live: for he has dealt with us according to his mercy

#### Verse 3 is Roman Gradual, Year B

All power has been given to me in heaven and on earth, alleluia; go therefore and teach all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, alleluia, allleuia.

# CORPUS CHRISTI COMMUNION ANTIPHON

Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him, says the Lord. (Roman Missal)

## Whoever Eats My Body

- 1. "Whoever eats my body," says the Lord,
  "And drinks my holy blood for them outpoured,
  Remains in me and I in them remain,
  Then everlasting life shall be their gain."
- 2. "This is my body given up for you, This is the chalice of the cov'nant new; Body and Blood, when you partake of these, Do so each time in memory of me."
- 3. Praise we the Father, praise we now the Son, And Holy Spirit, Blessed Three in One; Honor and glory to the Trinity, As was before, and evermore shall be. (*To Vs. 1*)
